Key Stage Two Years 3 - 6

As our children move through the school and become more grown up, we ask them to wear a gold tie and white shirt. The Buckton Fields tie can also be bought from The Schoolwear Shop.

Please can families support the school by:

- Purchasing footwear that is suitable for playing and learning. Please ensure that they are black or patent leather and have velcro straps or laces. Ballet pumps, heeled shoes and trainers aren't suitable as school shoes, (including black trainers with sport logos on the side), so please keep them for the weekend.
- Purchasing a Buckton Fields book bag for reading books, letters and learning resources and a PE bag.
- Ensuring that children wear small, plain hairbands and clips to tie their hair on P.E days. Headscarves and head wear are able to be worn, for religious observance, but please make your child's teacher aware to avoid any confusion.

- Labelling everything, so that we can return any misplaced items.

P.E. Uniform for Boys and Girls

- Royal blue shorts
- White polo top with the Buckton Fields logo
- Black plimsolls/trainers
- In the Winter months, navy blue jogging bottoms are advised for outdoor P.E.

A Little Request

Please don't allow your child to wear jewellery to school apart from small studded earrings and watches. If your child wears studs to school, please make sure that they can take their earrings out independently for P.E.
