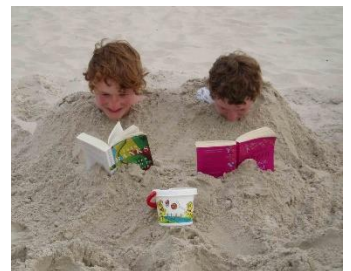
### Father's Day Celebration
